Faith Formation at Plymouth

Infants are held and cared for by adults who encircle them with God's love.

Toddlers & Pre-kindergarteners hear and experience basic Bible stories along with snacks, crafts and music to meet their growing curiosity.

Kindergarteners, First and Second Graders explore Bible stories and Christian values through interactive activities, drama and worship.

Third and Fourth Graders delve deeper into the Bible, learning how to use it as a reference and apply the stories to their lives.

Fifth and Sixth Graders come together through service projects — preparing lunch for The Angeline Women's Center, baking communion bread, and taking various leadership roles in church.

Confirmation

A two year class for **seventh and eighth graders**, confirmation explores religious traditions around the world as well as Christianity and the United Church of Christ.

At the completion of the class, students are invited to write their own Statement of Faith, participate in the Rite of Confirmation and become members of the church.



Youth Forum

A positive environment open to **high school students** at all stages of belief or unbelief.

Through retreats, service, and discussion, Youth Forum teens build community, examining the Christian scriptures and values together.
