Introduction

Plymouth Church Inspiration Grants connect people and opportunities to Plymouth's social justice mission. Grants are applied for and sponsored by Plymouth members who seek funding for a non-profit organization with which they are involved. These one-time awards go to organizations involved in social service, social justice, social action or social change. Sponsors may request up to \$2,000 for the organization. Plymouth's Community Service and Social Action (CSSA) Board will review applications and award grants. **Deadline is Friday, December 1, 2017.**

Appendix: Eligibility and Sponsor Responsibilities **Grant amount: Up to \$2,000, paid directly to the organization**

Eligibility

- Applications must be submitted by a Plymouth member (or members) ---the grant "sponsor(s)"

- Grant will be sent directly to the non-profit entity identified by the sponsor
- Grantees are not eligible if successfully proposed by the same sponsor in a prior year.
- Individuals may sponsor only one Inspiration Grant per calendar year.
- First-time sponsors will receive preference, all other factors being equal, to previous grant sponsors
- Grant sponsors must be unpaid volunteers of the organization

Grants will not fund:

- Organizations or their affiliates that are already receiving Plymouth funds this calendar year
- Projects or agencies whose activities are outside the areas of social service, social justice and social change

Grant Sponsor's Responsibilities

- Help CSSA publicize this organization and what is achieved by the Inspiration Grant through providing a *Herald* article, bulletin announcement, and other advertising about opportunities for involvement in this organization to encourage others at Plymouth who might consider volunteering.
